On 29th of June in 1776 San Francisco was founded.








Cable cars


Hollywood is a district in Los Angeles. It's very famous around the world as a place where movies and televisions are made.

Universal Studios Hollywood is a film studio and theme park in the San Fernando Valley area of Los Angeles country.



The original sign was only meant to last for 18 months


The Hollywood walk of fame is a historic landmark which consists of more than 2,700 five-pointed terrazzo and brass stars.



- San Diego is home to more small farms than any other U.S. city's.


Film Industry

In Los Angeles is the climate in summer hot and dry and in winter wet.









It's at the coastline of the Pacific ocean.


The record temperature was 38.9°C on June 20, 2008.







Huntington Beach has seven excellent beaches to choose from when you're picking a spot for a beach day.







Huntington Beach

For the most part, Highway no 1 runs parallel to the Pacific coastline.






San Diego Zoo

the red wolf and the California Condor is only queer in this Zoo to see. In 1982 it only gave 22 of this birds




The Zoo is one of the most beautiful zoos in the world.










San Diego
